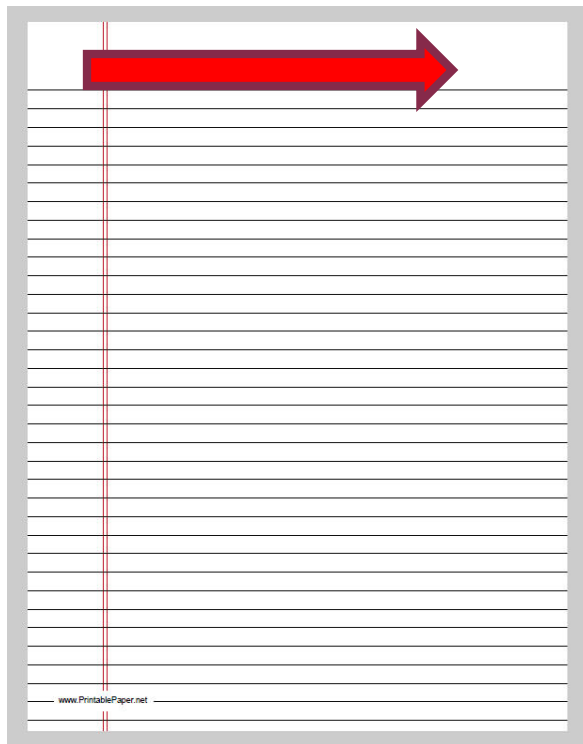


SETTING UP YOUR LOG BOOK FOR DATA COLLECTION

ALWAYS, ALWAYS!

- Name and date each page you work on! Use the famous “date box” in the upper right hand corner



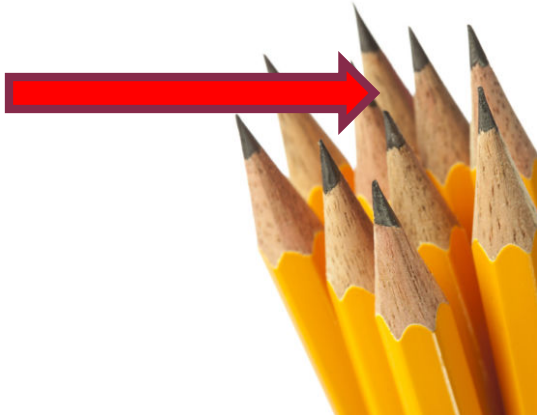
